RENOWNED boxer Danny Green, who is also the patron of WA Charity Direct, recently dropped in on a Kelmscott family in need.

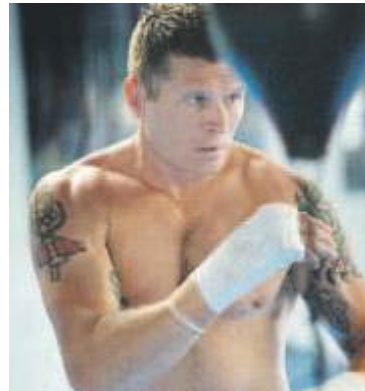
WA Charity Direct gave \$30,000 to the Spreadborough family so a hydrotherapy spa could be installed to help two of its members.

Robert Spreadborough is a quadriplegic and confined to a wheelchair, while his son Rueben has global developmental delay, a condition described as being similar to cerebral palsy.

Samantha Spreadborough is the prime carer for the family and applied for the funding help so both of her loved ones could receive vital hydrotherapy treatment.

Mrs Spreadborough thanked WA Charity Direct for its generous contribution, saying the new spa in their back yard reduced travelling and meant the family could enjoy an activity together.
